- High School Diploma or GED High School Equivalency.
- Have a qualifying BS degree or higher plus three (3) years of professional level experience in the soil erosion & sediment control profession. College transcripts are required
- (OR) Complete 7 years or more of professional level experience in the erosion & sediment control profession.
- Receive favorable responses from references familiar with your erosion & sediment control work.
- Subscribe to the CPESC Code of Conduct and Ethics
- Pass a written exam designed to determine proficiency in the principles, practices and legislation of erosion & sediment control.
